

Roadie Listing Guidelines

Your listing can consist of:

- Your name (as you would have it appear in a playbill)
- Your headshot (optional)
- Your email address (required)
- Your phone number (optional)
- Your artist website/blog URL (optional)
- Your résumé (required - up to 125 words max.)

For your résumé, consider including the following information about yourself:

- Relevant education and training in any of the performing arts, technical arts, or other related areas, including any past experience as a teacher in the arts.
- Relevant biographical information, e.g. how long you've lived in Tucson, specific artistic interests, or key influences.
- Past associations with performing arts groups and/or specific roles/productions you've been in or produced/directed.

In keeping with best practices, your résumé may not include Thank Yous, acknowledgements or other types of "shout outs" to individuals or organizations. Similarly, avoid descriptions of your favorite hobbies (e.g. knitting, cooking, curling, etc.) or pets.

Seriously. No pets.

Here is an example on which you can base your own résumé:

Maria Caprile (Director/Costumer) is from Spokane, Washington, where she was a resident artist of Interplayers Theatre and directed productions of *The Receptionist*, *Privilege*, *Eleemosynary*, and *The Graduate*. Maria was nominated for a Spokie for her direction of *The Christmas Schooner* for nationally acclaimed Spokane Civic Theatre and she has appeared in many of that company's productions, including *Gypsy* (Tessie Tura) where she played opposite Oscar and Emmy award winner Patty Duke. In Tucson, she has appeared in Winding Road's *August: Osage County*, *United*, and *Good People*. She is the author of the original play, *The Little Mermaid: A Tale of Aloha*, produced by Spokane Children's Theatre.

PLEASE NOTE: When writing your résumé, please follow this formatting scheme:

- Show names are *italicized, Upper & Lower Case*
- Roles played are in (parentheses) as regular text
- Theatre company names are regular text.
